children I sit down  
with pleasure to write  
those few lines to you  
hoping it will find you  
in good health as  
the departure of this leave  
we thanks be to God  
for his blessing us all  
I rec'd a letter from you  
on the 27<sup>th</sup> m<sup>r</sup>. which  
gives me great pleasure  
to hear that you were  
all well & main to  
inform you that we  
were paid 2 months pay  
yesterday and we  
expect to get 4 month  
rent for last year

Dear wife this is 15-doller  
from Tom. The same as  
usual which I hope you  
will be in good Health  
to receive it also I  
send you 5 dollars  
in this letter I hope  
it will arrive safe  
I could send you a  
little more but I expect  
to get a furlock but  
I fear it will be  
impossible write as  
soon as you get  
this give my love to  
the children and  
I am very glad that  
Mary can write so well  
tell her to try to write  
a little larger and  
in a short time will write

Dear wife I have  
not much to say now  
but hope I shall ever  
before long to see you all  
give my love to  
John and Martin  
and to all the Dugan  
girls  
No more at present  
but remain your  
truly Husband
