 one inch two short but

ye all to gather until
I have the pleasure of seeing
ye all once more for I am
Dreaming of ye very often
this last month and I hope
the Lord will keep ye in
good health until I see
ye again I have not
much more to say for
Every thing is very quiet
here at present
