Camp Baker # I

Dear wife I wrote to you the 20 of last month  
and got no answer as yet  
which leaves me uneasy  
not hearing from the children  
or how the war is getting along  
in the skincough also I  
rec'd a letter from you dated  
20 of January and on that  
same day wrote and send  
you in the letter & rec'd  
of 10 dollars that could be got  
at the mayor of Boston which  
I thought if you got the letter  
on the money that you should  
write if the children was  
not very sick till Mary to  
be a good girl and I will be  
Home to see you in March  
with the help of God

Dear wife. I feel Happy to  
day to able to write ~~the~~ to  
you Hoping this will find  
ye in good as this Leaves me  
in st present thanks be to god  
for his blessing to us all I mean  
to let you now that I have  
been very sick this last four  
weeks but thank be to god  
I am able to walk round now  
I sent a resignation in for  
furlow and I have got no res.  
as yet but if I do I shall  
put it back till after the next  
pay so as soon as you receive  
this letter writ to me for  
I want to hear from the children  
every week and every day  
if possible Remind me  
to Mary and matthew and  
tell magdal that I told her  
not to be coughing I hope  
also that Jobby is a good boy

I mean to tell you now that  
the winter is very bad  
As so far as snow and rain  
every other day which leaves  
very hard to get along in this  
part of the country for there  
is now roads what ever to have  
on I also could send you some  
money in this letter but as  
long as you did not write  
I thought I would not send  
any until I get the answer  
of this letter Let me now  
if you get 12 dollars & mon<sup>th</sup>  
from the city yet and let me  
have 6 of Martin Stoops with  
you and give him my best  
respect and also Mary Regan  
and Margaret and Elton Regan  
also Remind me to the  
Inquiring friends you have  
at present from you  
affectionate husband Lally
