much money you do
want to get a good
outfit for you and
Martha and Margaret
for I calculate to
take you to washing ton
or to California after
I get home

and if you
are getting out of the
Darboux before I
get home write (and
let me know.

And I will send you money
enough to go to the
School. I mean to inform
you that I won't stop
only as long as I can
here for I want to see you
once more

by the return of post card

& enough for her and
