Dear wife and children
I sit down with pleas
to write those ~~lines~~ ^{you} hoping
it will find you in good
Health as this leaves me in
at present Thanks be to God
for His Blessing done for
having safe to this day to have
the pleasure of hearing from
you once as long as I can not
see you but God is with
you and I hope He will bring
me safe home to see you
once more Your wife I would
write to you this last week
but I expected to be paid
so we expect to be paid
4 month pay this week
and I thought that you
might be expecting a little

So I Had An opportunity
to write to day and you
must excuse me for not
writing before since the
Battle for my Sack
was in Washington
since we came from
Garrison Landing and I Had
no way to write I would
make mention of the late
Battle in this letter but
with the help of God I
will be home this winter
to talk over it I hope you
will write and let me
know how you are getting
along or have you enough
to get along with so I felt
very uneasy this 2 months
past for not getting paid
but I hope before you
get this that I will have
another after this with money

Dear wife you will
give my love to my
little bries and tile
Mary & Martha and Margrett
and Johnay that I will
give them & slay ride
This winter and till thow
to be good girls and also
tile Margret and Martha
as swoon as I am paide
I will send them home
spice of gold that will
by them & good spice for
the winter give my love
to Martha and John & hope
they are well and in good
health and let me know
if John wife is out
or he stop to yare give
my love to Margret and
Ellon Augan and the
neighbours

I will conclude
by sending you my
Blessing - And hope
to see you again to-morrow
